SCHOLARSHIP AWARD TO PROMOTE PARTICIPATION AT THE IAHC ANNUAL IAHC CONFERENCE



The **Leininger Culture Care Scholarship Award** is intended for nurses who advance culture care nursing. The prestigious Award is given in honor of Dr. Madeleine Leininger and funded by Dr. Marilyn Ray. An Award of \$1,000.00 is offered each year towards expenses for conference participation.

Dr. Madeleine Leininger was the first nursing scholar to declare that "caring is the essence of nursing" and contributed to the creation of the International Association for Human Caring with caring science scholars. She is the founder of Transcultural Nursing and the Transcultural Nursing Society and the Council on Nursing and Anthropology. Dr. Leininger was my mentor for my PhD in Transcultural Nursing and the study of caring within the institutional culture and the development of the Theory of Bureaucratic Caring. I am happy to support students or faculty who are committed to applying for funding to support research, practice the education of transcultural caring and present their scholarship at the annual IAHC conference.

Purpose of the Award

The purpose of the Award is to support nurse scholars who focus on culture care/caring in the discipline of nursing.

Criteria

Applicants for this award must meet the following criteria:

- Registered nurse committed to advance culture caring science in nursing.
- Member of the International Association for Human Caring
- An active student, teacher, researcher, clinician or consultant who supports human caring as the essence of nursing.

Process and Expectations

- The applicant will submit an Application Packet with the following contents:
 - A one-page paper describing the applicant's scholarship focused on culture caring in nursing.
 - If an abstract for a podium or poster presentation has been submitted, the abstract replaces the one-page paper.
 - A separate cover page with
 - Applicant's name
 - Contact information (address, phone number, and email)
 - If the applicant is a student: College / university where student is enrolled & a reference letter from a faculty member who knows his/her work Email Application to the IAHC Award and Scholarship Committee at scholarships@humancaring.org

Post Award Responsibilities

- At presentations or in publications, funded research and scholarly works, related to this award, awardee should indicate that it is "Funded in part by the IAHC Leininger Culture Care Scholarship Award."
